

#### GRIDLEY PRIVATE CEMETERY

This is a small family burying ground on the premises now owned by the heirs of Abner Peck, on the west side of the highway just south of the four corners a short distance south of Southampton village. It is owned by the heirs of Henry Gridley. Henry Gridley owned this place and made a small family cemetery there. It is the only private cemetery in town. It is in a good state of preservation, although there are no burials there to-day. The first burial is that of Lois, wife of Leman Gridley - died July 23, 1835 at 68 yrs.
